# THE TAVERN'S OFFERINGS

## BY THE GLASS/BOTTLE

### Red

#### **Scopa Sangiovese '16 (\$7/\$24)**

A Tuscan classic with raspberry fruit. A great alternative to Merlot.

#### **Petit Canet Pays d'Oc '16 (\$8/\$27)**

Elevated grape juice with an earthy undertone: you have to try this.

#### **Lavradores de Feitoria Douro '15 (\$9/\$29)**

Medium bodied, with red and black fruit. A quaffable Portuguese blend.

### White

#### **Scopa Pinot Grigio '16 (\$6/\$20)**

A fruity and friendly wine, with tons of character for the price. Goes with everything.

#### **Bleeker Chardonnay '16 (\$8/\$28)**

Slightly creamy, slightly toasty, tropical and tree fruits like lychee, pear and apple.

#### **Sete Cepas Albarino '16 (\$9/\$30)**

Dry, with apple and lemon notes. A dry, dense, zingy wine. Some typical Penedes salinity.

### Sparkling

#### **Da Mar Prosecco NV (\$9/\$30)**

Bubbles go with everything. Perfect for toasting a victory or as a consolation prize.

### Orange & Rose

#### **Bodini Rose of Malbec '17 (\$8/\$28)**

Medium bodied and fruit-forward. Not too crisp, but still dry.

### Sparkling Cider

#### **Wolffer Rose Cider (\$9)**

Bone dry rose from Wolffer Vineyards in Long Island. Tannic, very wine-like.

#### **Bordelet Sidre NV (\$10)**

Normandy apple cider from a Parisian Sommelier. Light, faintly sweet. 330mL bottle.

#### **Bordelet Poire NV (\$12)**

Normandy pears. Unusual, but oh so quaffable. Some sweetness, pure pear. 330mL bottle.

## BY THE BOTTLE

### Red

#### **Altos de la Hoya Monastrell '15 (\$32)**

Distinctly Spanish in its fruit and underlying spice. Meat brings out a rich earthiness, similar to its Rhône counterparts.

#### **La Galoche Beaujolais '16 (\$41)**

Light, structured, cherry and strawberry. A modern style Beaujolais with plenty of fruit.

#### **Sidekick Cabernet Sauvignon '15 (\$45)**

A less-jammy style of California Cab. Cherry, red currant, hints of cocoa. The perfect sidekick to your meal.

#### **La Posta Pizzella Vineyard '16 (\$44)**

A structured, refined Malbec from Valle de Uco. Malbec, elevated, from a single family vineyard, and with a woman winemaker.

### White

#### **Mas Candi Xarel'lo Desig '16 (\$49)**

Clean and weighty, with lime zest and white floral notes with a soft texture and bright fruit.

### Sparkling

#### **Albarici Lambrusco NV (\$36)**

A frizzante red from Emilia Romana. Dry and beyond delicious. A staff go-to.

## CIDER

### Still

#### **South Hill Cider Pack Basket '15 (\$50)**

A dry, crisp, and saline cider. No bubbles here! Similar to Muscadet. Best with food.

### Sparkling

#### **Phonograph Baccata NV (\$40)**

Crabapples, Macintosh, and Northern Spy for a tart, dry, fizzy cider that appeals to most.
